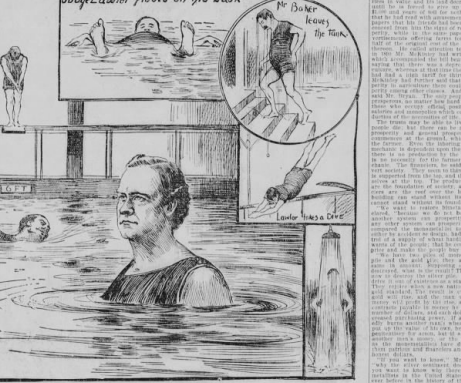
BRYAN GOES SWIMMING.

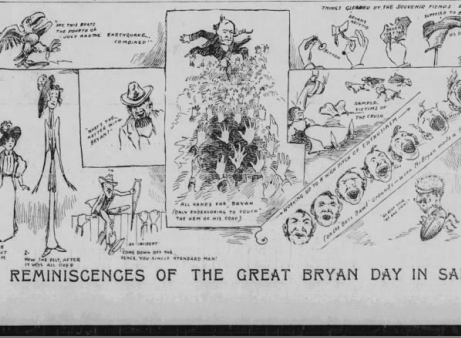
