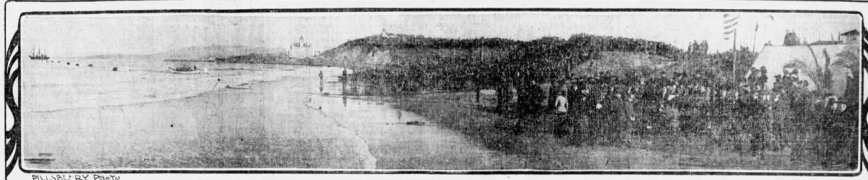
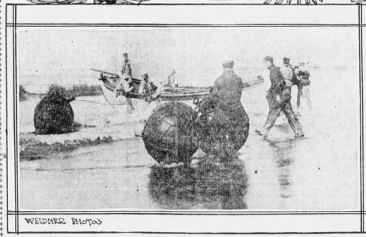
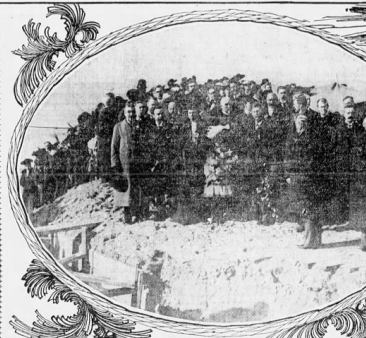


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GREAT THROG FLOCKS TO BEACH

Notable Event in San Francisco's History Attracts a Great Crowd of Spectators to the Edge of the Pacific.

CLARENCE H. MACKAY WIRES GOOD NEWS TO NATION'S EXECUTIVE AT WASHINGTON

San Francisco, December 14, 1902.
To Hon. Theodore Roosevelt, President of the United States, Washington, D. C.:
I have the honor to inform you that the end of the Honolulu cable was successfully brought to shore this morning, Governor Geary being present. C. M. MACKAY, President Commercial Pacific Cable Company.
The cable was formerly filed by Miss Lucile Geary, daughter of the Governor of California. Her sentiment was neither studied nor prompted. As the end of the great coil came above the ship, accompanied by Clarence H. Mackay, whose hand she held, ran to the water edge and smashed a bottle of champagne upon it, exclaiming with appropriate dramatic emphasis:
"To the memory of John W. Mackay I christen this Pacific Cable. Good luck to thee. May it always carry messages of happiness!"
Then Mr. Mackay took one of the little girl's hands in both of his and said:
"Thank you! Thank you! It was beautiful!"
